

NOTES ON CHEVRON SUNOL PIPELINE  
MEETING ON MAY 30, 2006

URS had a proposed agenda and explained their position re continued SVE. Items of discussion included:

- 1) Absence of groundwater contamination with the exception of MW-1, which has had free product. ACEH contended that contamination had reached the bedrock.
- 2) Chevron believes there may not be a large source in soil downslope from release.
- 3) Chevron does not know who they would contact for an independent evaluation. URS considered an expert.
- 4) Chevron wanted to consider modeling to show how much fuel had evaporated. ACEH said this would not be very convincing and would rely upon soil and groundwater data to estimate mass.
- 5) URS wants to install one additional SVE well to south in gravel layer and cover part of hillside in plastic periodically.

Action Items:

- 1) Chevron and URS to assume that large mass exists downslope from release.
- 2) Chevron and URS to consider other methods including directional drilling from road at top of slope.
- 3) ACEH to provide comments on SWI report.
