## Hello Michael and Mark:

Thank you for coming in yesterday to meet with Dilan Roe and me. As Dilan requested, I am following up to summarize our discussion on the further investigation and other information needed to help bring this case to closure. It is as follows:

- 1) Retabulation of the groundwater analytical results and the analytical results of the soil confirmation sampling from the excavation so that they include the laboratory reporting limits.
- 2) Sampling of fill using the methods of 50 to 100 feet grid spacing or a method based on the estimate of the amount of fill put back into the excavation.
- 3) Analysis of the fill for potential contamination in accordance with the DTSC 2001 Information Advisory for clean imported fill material.
- 4) Sampling of groundwater at the areas of the oil seepage from the north sidewall and the former location of MW-5. If feasible, sampling should occur north of the seepage on the adjacent property.
- 5) A sufficient number of soil and groundwater sampling points in the areas of the former locations of the two removed USTs and location of the closed in-place UST in order to adequately characterize these areas for potential contamination.
- 6) Figures submitted of proposed work should be large-scale in order provide enough detail for us to assess the proposed work.

Regarding the required submission of data on GeoTracker, I do see that some reports were submitted. However, other electronic data that is required is still missing, including analytical data for soil and groundwater, boring logs, and site maps.
