### Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

### **Responsible Party Identification**

#### Existence of Unauthorized Release

An underground storage tank (UST) was discovered in the area of the loading dock during site investigation activities in 2005. The UST and associated piping were removed on August 17, 2005. The UST was observed to be rusty and stained with many holes. The soils surrounding the UST were visibly stained and had a hydrocarbon odor. Total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) as diesel and TPH as gasoline were detected in soil samples collected in the area of the UST at concentrations up to 5,090 and 877 milligrams per kilogram, respectively. The observations during tank removal and results from the soil sampling during the UST excavation indicate that an unauthorized release occurred.

### Responsible Party Identification

Equity Office Properties owned the property at the time of the UST discovery and was identified as a responsible party for the fuel leak case in a Notice of Responsibility dated February 17, 2006. Equity Office Properties is a responsible party because they are the former owner of property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).

700 Independent LP purchased the property on or about June 26, 2008. 700 Independent Road LP is a responsible party because they are the current owner of the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).
