Existence of Unauthorized Release

The three underground storage tanks (USTs) were removed from operation in May 1986. Four soil samples collected at the time of removal were below the detection limits. However, no groundwater samples were collected at the time. A subsequent sampling event performed in 2001 revealed maximum concentrations of 87 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), 100 mg/kg total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd) and 1 mg/kg benzene in soil from boring S-2. Groundwater was not collected from this boring. TPHg was detected in water at a maximum concentration of 78 micrograms per liter (ug/L), TPHd at a maximum concentration of 340 ug/L and benzene at 5.7 ug/L. In 2006, further investigation detected 18,000 ug/L TPHg and 690 ug/l benzene in groundwater.

Responsible Party Identification

Mobil Oil Corporation Owned and operated underground storage tanks and the property at this location. Mobil meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because they had control over an underground storage tank at the time or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4) and they owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred, (Definition 3).

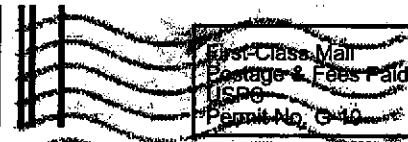

Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R. Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."
