I have yet to receive the CAP from Joseph Cotton, but I have received/reviewed the original remediation work plan that we discussed during our original conference call. Given our original discussion of the site and the existing subsurface conditions, I would be hesitant to definitively state that the remediation would lead to closure. ACEH is cautious/conservative in making a declarative statement regarding site closure. However, it is very likely the proposed site remediation would result in the removal of free phase TPH and mitigate soil vapor and groundwater contamination beneath the site and thus result in site cleanup.

Let me know what our next step is.
