Dear Mr. Wickham:

Your letter dated August 12, 2008, regarding the proceedings referenced above, has been forwarded to me to try to determine how Bank of the West is involved and who within the Bank may know about the situation. Bank of the West is the successor in interest to United California Bank ("UCB"). Sanwa Bank California changed its name to United California Bank on July 2, 2001, but UCB was acquire by Bank of the West on April 1, 2002. Thus, the institution was "United California Bank" for only a 9 month period. A telephone directory for that

period lists Ray Garnica as an employee of UCB in its Wealth Management Department, but in San Diego. I'm hoping that you can provide additional information regarding UCB's involvement with the property in question. For example, do you know if UCB's participation was as a representative of a trust or other fiduciary estate? Was UCB a lender? Do you know the name of the real party in interest (trustor, borrower, owner of the property at the time)?

I don't know when your letter was actually mailed to Mr. Garnica at the former address of UCB's headquarters (601 South Figueroa, Los Angeles, CA) but I am attempting to find out who in the Bank knows more about this situation, and your assistance would be most appreciated. I can be reached by telephone, e-mail, or any other method specified below.
