Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Responsible Party Identification

Existence of Unauthorized Release

In May 2007, three inactive underground storage tanks were removed from the site. Prior to removal, all three UST were triple rinsed, and then rinsate water was removed from the tanks and disposed of offsite. All USTs were rendered inert with dry ice prior to their removal. Soil sampling conducted at UST #3 and UST #4 detected low concentrations of <5 parts milligrams per kilogram (ppm) TPHd, while benzene was not detected above laboratory reporting limits. However, at the location of UST #2 TPHd, TPH as kerosene and TPH as bunker oil were detected in soil at concentrations of up to 320 ppm, 330 ppm and 400 ppm, respectively. Additional over-excavation was completed and confirmation soil sampling did not detect TPHd or TPH as bunker oil above laboratory detection limits. Furthermore, grab groundwater samples collected from the tank pit at former UST #2 detected TPHd and TPH as kerosene at concentrations of up to 33,000 micrograms per liter and 28,000 ppb, respectively.

Responsible Party Identification

Pacific Shops Inc. is the current property owner and has owned the property since 1962. Pacific Shops Inc is the primary responsible party because the unauthorized release occurred while Pacific Shops Inc. owned the property (definition 3) and had control of the USTs at the time of or following an unauthorized release.
