We are in the process of demolishing the conveyor culvert. After removing some of the piping we have discovered that the conveyor tunnel is welded together in two foot long sections of corrugated metal. The conveyor was pneumatic and there has been no indication of any contamination. Sampling at each seam will force us to take nearly 100 samples.

We propose to sample every 10 feet and, in addition, any area that has indications of contamination.
