## Mr. Langbin:

At the request of ExxonMobil Environmental Services (EMES), on behalf of Exxon Mobil Corporation, Cardno is notifying you of upcoming on-site and off-site activities scheduled to begin Thursday, October 8, 2015. Cardno will be installing four soil vapor extraction wells (SVE4 through SVE7) at the site and two groundwater monitoring wells (MW9 and MW10) in the public right-of-way near the site. The work is being directed by the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency, Environmental Health Services. This work is expected to take approximately three days to complete and will require a drill rig and a support truck at the work locations. The locations of the proposed wells are shown on the attached Extended Site Plan.

Waste generated during field activities will be stored on site in 55-gallon drums. Following characterization, the drums will be removed and transported to an EMES-approved disposal facility.

Cardno will make every attempt to minimize disruptions to business operations to the extent possible. Cardno will employ various pedestrian and vehicular traffic control measures (i.e., cones, delineators, and caution tape) to limit access to the work zones as necessary. These traffic control measures are designed to ensure the safety of our personnel, station personnel, and the general public.
