Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Existence of Unauthorized Release

A Phase II environmental site assessment conducted in 2008 to assess the former gasoline station that was present in this portion of the site, revealed maximum concentrations of 99,000 micrograms per liter (ug/L) total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd) in groundwater from B-1, 77,000 ug/L total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) in B-2 and 1,500 ug/l benzene in B-2 in groundwater. Free product was also present in B-1.

The maximum TPHd concentration in soil [7,200 milligrams per kilogram (mg/Kg)] was detected in B-1 at a depth of 10.5 feet below ground surface (bgs). Maximum TPHg concentrations of 1,400 mg/Kg were detected in borings B-1 and B-2 from 10.5 ft bgs and the maximum benzene concentration (13 mg/kg) was detected in B-2 from 10.5 feet bgs.

Responsible Party Identification

ExxonMobil already owned the underground storage tanks (USTs) when Mr. Jerome Blank purchased the property in the early to mid 1960s until Exxon removed the USTs under a March 28, 1983 City of Albany Building Department permit. ExxonMobil is a responsible party for the site because they owned or operated an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1) had control over an underground storage tank at the time or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

Muriel Blank purchased the property in March 1984. The Muriel Blank Trust was the property owner at the time and following an unauthorized petroleum hydrocarbon release(s). The Muriel Blank Trust is a responsible party for the site because they own the property where an unauthorized release occurred, (Definition 3).
