If possible, I would like to meet with both of you along with Cem Atabek of Ninyo and Moore to discuss our site #RO2983 located at 925 Stanford Avenue in Oakland, California. May 2011 will mark three years since we had two underground storage tanks and one above ground tank removed along with approximately 46 tons of soil which was replaced with clean fill.

I realize that your office was reassigned to other projects and has only recently been able to tackle the backlog of sites closures. I would like to bring Cem in to answer any questions you may have regarding our site or the Preferential Pathway Survey & Site Assessment Work Plan (from July 28 2009) and/or the Soil and Groundwater Investigation Report (dated June 2, 2010).
