Since DIPE, TAME, ETBE, 1,2-DCA, EDB, & ethanol have not been detected in any of the 14 soil samples or 3 grab groundwater samples (Delta's Phase II Investigation and Well Installations), and DIPE, TAME, & ETBE have not been detected in any of the 5 quarterly groundwater monitoring events conducted to date, I request that ACEH allow us to eliminate these analysis from the groundwater monitoring program and the up-coming CPT investigation.
