Debbie,

With reference to the LTCP I think it would be premature until we establish soil concentrations in the upper 5 ft zone; especially since groundwater can be argued to be very shallow at the site and it is a bit of an open question if soil has been adequately sampled above the water level (see multiple bore logs with extensive "wet" zones above the open triangle symbol indicating first water). I suspect we might be able to eliminate some analytes in the future; I am very open to that, if or once, it makes sense.
