Dear Underground Container Owner:

This letter responds to your inquiry as to whether the unused or abandoned tank on your property must be registered.

You must register a tank if it is structurally sound, previously contained a hazardous substance, and could contain a hazardous substance in the future, even though it is now empty. If the tank is unusable because it has been sealed, has one or more holes, or has been filled with a material such as sand, then you do not have to register it.

If you decide, based on the above explanation, that you do not need to register your tank, then no further action is required. If you decide that you need to register your tank, contact us to obtain the necessary forms by writing The Underground Tanks Program, at the above address, or by calling Betty Moreno at (916) 324-1262. If you need to register, please do so as soon as possible. Thank you for your cooperation.
