Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Existence of Unauthorized Release

A June 3, 2011 report entitled "Underground Storage Tank Removal Report" by Sierra West Consultants, Inc. documented the removal of four underground storage tanks (USTs) from a service station that had ceased operation in 1995. Three of the four USTs contained product at the time of their removal and holes were observed in the same three USTs after their removal. The fourth UST was empty at removal but stained soil was found beneath it. Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as Gasoline (TPHG) at 1,990 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) were detected in a soil sample taken from beneath the USTs at a depth of 13 feet below ground surface indicating an unauthorized release had occurred at this site.

Responsible Party Identification

The Heirs of the Estate of Ms. Mary L. Wright are the responsible party for the site because the Heirs of the Estate of Ms. Mary L. Wright owned the UST used for the storage of a hazardous substance, owned the UST immediately before the discontinuation of its use, and are the current owners of the property where an unauthorized release occurred. (Definition 1, 2, and 3).
