Hi Jerry,

Thank you for taking my call earlier today. As I indicated in our phone conversation, the attached analytical data indicated that the groundwater grab sample (SP.01W) collected from soil probe location SP.01 had concentrations of TPH-D and TPH-MO at 5,500 and 29,000 μ g/L, respectively. Site conditions (saturated gravel base) may have contributed to contaminating the grab sample collected with oil impacted surface water. It is our opinion that the collected sample does not adequately characterize local groundwater conditions and that a more representative groundwater sample should be collected. Our recommendation would be to return to the Site and install a temporary groundwater monitoring well, using a pre-pack monitoring well and appropriate surface/sanitary seals. Once installed we would surge/develop, allow the well to equilibrate, then purge and sample the well. The groundwater sample collected will be analyzed consistent with the previously approved workplan (TPH-G, TPH-D, TPH-MO, and VOC's). Please review the attached data and let us know if you concur with this proposed workplan addenda. Thank you for your time and assistance with this project.
