Phone call with Erik Garcia of Quest to discuss questions from RP.

- 1) They should remove the pile of scale near pond. This will likely be a requirement from CUPA. The LOP deals with subsurface contamination and the CUPA deals with waste disposal.
- 2) If the monitoring wells are installed and are dry, will they need to wait months for water to come in. I indicated that we would consider the hydrogeology of site and whether reasonable attempt to obtain water from first water-bearing layer had been made. Not likely to wait long period of time with dry well.
- 3) LOP will not require removal of the pond. Facility decommissioning would fall under CUPA requirements.
- 4) There are several natural gas pipelines in the area that potentially could be a source of contamination.
