## Hello Mark:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) has reviewed the December 2, 2016 Low Threat Case Closure Request prepared on Chevron's behalf by GHD for the referenced case. ACDEH has evaluated the data in conjunction with the case files, and in reference to the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCBs) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP). Based on ACDEH staff review, we have determined that the site does not meet the LTCP General Criteria f (Secondary Source Removal), Media-Specific Criteria for Groundwater, Media-Specific Criteria for Vapor Intrusion to Indoor Air, and the Media-Specific Criteria for Direct Contact. Consequently, ACDEH must deny closure. We will send a Directive Letter next week with supporting rationale.
