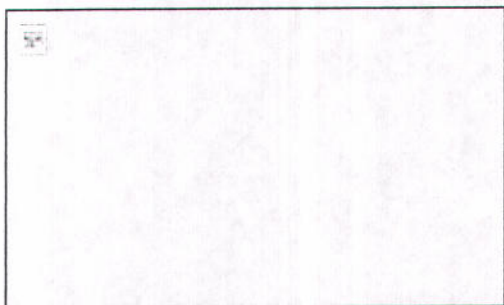

I have had a brief conversation with Ms. Donna Drogos (ACEH) regarding the Ed's Liquor property in Oakland (See attached report). Based on the characteristics of the contamination encountered, it is my recommendation to transfer the case from the Oakland Fire Department to the ACEH's Local Oversight program. If you agree, please authorize the transfer via an email to me and Ms. Drogos. The former on-site gasoline service station was a Tidewater Oil Co. facility which, over time, was absorbed by Chevron.
