I believe that we are still waiting for a data gap work plan as requested in the December 17, 2012 directive letter, as modified by the December 20, 2012 email directive letter (to include asbestos). Technical Comment 1 has been completed (Geotracker compliance), but I am not aware that there has been a response to Technical Comment 2. Chris Markowski requested submittal an extension to May 10, but that is now in the past and the submittal is overdue. You can check Geotracker or our website to see what documents have been provided, and see where it stands, but I've also copied Chris so he can provide any additional information available.
