Hi Paul,

Thanks for getting back to me. We were thinking of collecting 4 or 5 surface soil samples (6" depth) near the area where we previously detected slightly elevated levels of asbestos fibers. We hope to determine if the one elevated sample was a fluke or are we dealing with a large hotspot of asbestos impacted soil. Mark Detterman is fine with this plan. I know your consultant has previously submitted a workplan to Alameda County EH. Perhaps we can amend the figure showing the sampling location to reflect this new strategy and resubmit. Our office is prepared to send one of our scientist to collect the samples. We would also pay for the lab analysis and we can prepare a letter/report summarizing the finding of the investigation. Let me know if you have any concerns with this approach. The lab analysis takes about 2 weeks. Document preparation also about that long so pending any complications we I think we can resolve this issue in about a month. Thanks again for your help.
