Several monitoring wells were either designated to remain active or to be closed on the Marketplace and Nielsen sites, in accordance with the County approved "Final Proposal to Remediate the Marketplace and Nielsen Sites" (Earth Metrics Incorporated, p. 6-2 revised May 16, 1988). All wells that were designated to be closed have been properly abandoned by Earth Metrics, using appropriate well closure methods and materials. The status of existing wells that were designated to remain active is summarized in Table 1.

Figures 1, 2, and 3 show the locations of the above wells. All wells were installed by Woodward-Clyde Consultants.










FIGURE 2. FORMER TANK LOCATIONS AND PREVIOUS BORING LOCATIONS








FIGURE 3. FORMER NIELSON TRUCK LINES SITE DETAILING BORING LOCATIONS AND FORMER UNDERGROUND TANK LOCATIONS
