Chris,

Upon further review and discussion, Archstone has been advised that Region 9 PCB will be responsible for the oversight and administration of the cleanup and not the DTSC or ACDEH. With respect to an update, we have not yet received approval from the Federal EPA to move forward with the cleanup. We submitted our final self-implementation plan on 11/30/12 and expect to receive comments this week. Subject to EPA approval, we will begin with the next phase of demolition and cleanup later this month or early January. Manifests and chain of custody will be assembled and finalized within 30-45 days thereafter.

With respect to recent test results, a series of 35 discreet samples were taken which yielded 2 PCB hits in the soil – immediately adjacent to the sump within the transformer room. Non-detect levels are believed to be at 5.5'-6' – of which, final results are pending and expected this afternoon.

I've included the submitted implementation plan as an attachment for your reference. Please let me know if you have any further questions.
