Mr. Liu,

As mentioned in the referenced directive letter, the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) has been notified by the State Water Resource Control Board (SWRCB) that investigations and any corrective actions required for the diesel fuel release at the northwest corner of the site will not be reimbursed under claim No. 20212 (which is apparently associated with the waste oil UST only). They have additionally informed ACDEH that an Unauthorized Release Report (URR) must be submitted so that ACDEH can oversee the appropriate steps. This should allow you to submit for reimbursement with the UST Cleanup Fund for actions associated with the diesel release. Apparently, combining the two releases under one GeoTracker Global I.D. / lead agency case number will create issues with reimbursement through the Fund.
