Hi Ashley, I just talked to JR about the plan. We agreed that due to the location of a former building foundation found along the existing building side of the VMS trench, we will modify the trench design to be approximately 20" wide (not 36 inches) and 4 feet deep (not 3 feet).

We feel the trench operations will remove the contamination found along the base of the existing building and will still provide sufficient material to provide a barrier for vapors that will be vented.
