I looked through my correspondence file and did not see one that I thought I had sent. Here it is- I do not understand the rationale for the clean ups. What is being stripped out? Do you have access to data having no clean up as well as with?

The previous import, for the lead excavations, was for less material and I was provided with a lab report for two samples. The proposed import has one sample.

Here are my questions re the analyses performed:

1. If I recall correctly, the Stevens Creek quarry is in the Franciscan. Why was SGC done for the TEPH analysis?
2. SVOC analysis was performed using GPC clean up. I am not familiar with this clean up method- why was it performed?
3. OCP and PCB analysis was performed with GPC and Florisil clean up. I am not familiar with these- again, why were they performed?
