I want to add clarification to my earlier email- per the SMP prepared for the site, construction activities in the area where the contamination was encountered should have halted and, if possible, moved to elsewhere at the site. The work stoppage in the area of contamination will remain in effect until the contamination is characterized, the area delineated, and ACDEH authorizes resumption of work. Re the scope of analysis, if soil is being considered for offsite disposal, ACDEH is of the opinion that it is prudent the analysis scope include the profile of the potential receiving facility. ACDEH is unaware if excavation was occurring when the contamination was encountered.

With regard to keeping us informed, please provide ACDEH with a site figure indicating where the area the contamination was encountered, photographs of the area showing the soil discoloration and the laboratory analysis report when it becomes available. Following receipt and review of the requested documentation, ACDEH will discuss the findings with you and on how best to proceed in this area.
