Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) has received an electronic correspondence from Dan Schreiner of Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) dated Thursday, September 22, 2016 regarding the proposed drilling scheduled for Monday, September 26, 2016 at the subject site. The electronic correspondence proposes the advancement of ten (10) soil bores to a depth of approximately 5 feet below the ground surface (bgs) for the collection of soil gas samples for one or more of eight listed compounds and one mixture. Sample analysis will be performed by an on-site mobile laboratory.

ACEH has not been provided a sufficient amount of time to perform a complete review the proposed activities, including boring placement, number of soil bores, and sample analysis scope. As expressed in prior meetings for the case, ACEH has expressed concern with the adequacy of site characterization. Therefore, ACEH suggests the soil gas samples be analyzed for the full-scan of the proposed EPA 8260 analysis.

ACEH will release the hold on the drilling permit to allow the permitting process to go forward.
