Thank you for the notification. If the contaminated soil is in the vicinity of the former elevators, we request that you include TPH as hydraulic oil to the scope of analyses presented below. Please add TPH as motor oil if in the vicinity of the clarifier.

Are there plans to perform any excavation of the contaminated soil at this time? ACDEH recommends that the receiving facility be contacted for the soil disposal profile.

Please keep our agency informed of your observations.

Keith - just a note to let you know the contractor encountered some discolored soil with odors under the sidewalk near Building 4. Stantec will collect samples of the material. I am on my way out there now to assist with next steps. My current recommendation is to sample for TPHg, TPHd, VOCs, PAHs, and metals on a 24-hr turnaround basis.

Please let me know if you have additional input at this stage.
