Hello Robert:

During our meeting, the decision not to collect confirmation samples was based on the site conceptual model that water would fill the excavation. Because the site conceptual model was not accurate and water did not fill the excavation, we are now requesting confirmation samples, which will provide another line of evidence.

Rain is not forecast for next week, so please perform the confirmation sampling next week and as requested in the October 6, 2017 Directive Letter include the analytical results, photos, trench logs, and backfill documentation with the Remedial Action Report. I have provided a report extension below:

Hi Karel -

There isn't very much water (or at least there wasn't yesterday). At the meeting we were specifically told NOT to collect confirmation soil samples from the sidewalls and our workplan states that we are not to collect confirmation sidewall samples. The only soil sample to be collected is from the stockpiled soil for landfill profiling purposes. This has already been completed and the sample analyzed on a rush basis. Attached is the analytical report. During the stockpile sampling I collected the sample from the darkest black material I could find.

Hi Karel -
We completed the excavation this morning. There wasn't a whole lot of black material, mostly surrounding some buried metal debris that we removed. The sidewalls look brown/dark brown and there was never really any odor anywhere nor PID readings above zero. I've collected a sample for the lab and will be heading there shortly. The final dimensions of the excavation were 5 foot wide by 21 long by 5 to 6 feet deep. Only a small amount of water seeped into the bottom of the excavation on the western side.
I told them to hold off on backfilling for a day or two in the event you want to come out to take a look at the excavation. I've taken pictures that I will include in my report, and I've attached a couple here.
