#### Karel –

Per our phone conversation today, I am providing the following to address your concerns regarding drilling at the site, and complete the County drilling permit application process.

Your area of concern appears to be further south near the Main Shop Building (referred to as the Oakland Shop Building in the second figure I've attached to compliment the one you sent, which shows our proposed geotechnical boring to be drilled to 25 feet using a truck rig equipped with a 6-inch hollow-stem augers.

The testing program would be for disposal of the cuttings only; environmental testing and monitoring is not a part of our geotechnical exploration program. The analytical testing would consist of the following:

VOCs + TPH-G EPA 8260 SVOCs EPA 8270 CAM 17 Metals TPH-Extractable (Diesel, Motor Oil, Stoddard Solvent and Mineral Spirits)

The landfill for final disposition of the soil cuttings will need to be determined based on the results of the analytical testing program.


