Hello Dan,

I wanted to follow up after our meeting last week to add some comments to what had already been discussed regarding the reorganization of the analytical results in tables. Besides organizing them the way Dilan had discussed in terms of sample identification, media, respective investigation, and analytes, you should continue noting at the bottom of each table the ESLs for both residential and commercial/industrial.

Also, regarding VOCs found in all three media, you should cross-check the MDLs and RLs against the ESLs. (For those analytical tables for which RLs were listed, we would prefer MDLs if you are able to obtain these from the laboratory.) I did a brief overview of the analytical reports for the Phase II investigation that was performed in July 2015, and compared the MDLs and RLs for VOCs in different media to their respective ESLs. For groundwater vapor intrusion for shallow water, there was at least one constituent, vinyl chloride, for which the MDL was above the residential ESL. In the tables, please note any constituent for which the MDL or RL is above the respective residential and/or commercial ESL.
