This provides written notice that Alameda County Department of Environmental Health has received a request and intends to enter into a Voluntary Remedial Action Agreement with the responsible party pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 10480 in approximately 10 working days.

- (a) The Responsible Party will be Holiday Development.
- (b) The site owner is Holiday Development, 1201 Pine Street, Suite 151, Oakland, CA 94607.
- (c) The Voluntary Remedial Action Agreement will apply to a site at 5th Street and Magnolia Streets in Oakland.
- (d) The purpose of the Remedial Action Agreement will be to review results from a Phase II site investigation and a proposed commercial site development.
