- (c) The Voluntary Remedial Action Agreement will apply to 10500 International Boulevard, Oakland.
- (d) ACDEH previously provided regulatory oversight of a case at this site. The case was closed in March 2014 with site management requirements due to residual contamination. The purpose of the Remedial Action Agreement will be to review current site conditions and a proposed change in land use.
