Mr. Nowell,

Per our conversation this week, Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC) received the attached letter on Monday July 24th from Mr. Watrous-Geyliger, who represents the property owners. I have been assigned this case and will need to bring my consultant onboard. In addition, due to the age of the case, I will be requesting files from off-site to determine historical conditions and layout of tanks onsite.

As no groundwater has been conducted in 11 years, current conditions are unknown. Therefore, CEMC respectfully requests that the Data Gap Investigation Plan and Focused Site Conceptual Model be placed on temporary hold until we have had the opportunity to investigate the well network, and collect a round or two of samples to establish a technical baseline for further evaluation.

Please let me know if this is an acceptable path for you. We can provide an update by October 13, 2017 on the current status of our evaluation and our proposed next steps.
