Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC), respectfully requests an extension for the Soil and Groundwater Investigation Report requested by Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) letter dated July 7, 2017. In an email dated August 31, 2017, ACDEH approved a request for an extension to November 17, 2017.

CEMC are currently working with the property owner and their counsel to secure an access agreement to advance the soil borings and install and subsequently monitor the wells. Additional time is necessary for all parties to agree on the access agreement, and therefore a second extension for the submittal of the investigation report is requested.
