Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party four ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

Existence of Unauthorized Release

Between November and December 2017, five soil borings were advanced and sixteen soil samples and four grab groundwater samples were collected. Additionally, five sub-slab vapor pins were advanced inside the onsite building and 5 sub-slab vapor samples were collected. Concentrations of up to 979 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) of Total Petroleum Hydrocarbon as gasoline (TPH-g) were reported in soil at a depth of 24 feet below ground surface in soil and 24,500 micrograms per liter (μ g/l) TPH-g, 6,460 μ g/l TPH as diesel, and 1,200 μ g/l benzene were reported in the grab groundwater samples. Sub-slab vapor TPH-g concentrations were reported up to 2,270 micrograms per cubic meter. These data indicate that an unauthorized release from an underground storage tank (UST) and/or UST system components has occurred at the site.
